Solardelphia Wins Philadelphia 100 Award – Ranked Second Fastest Growing Company in the Region

DOYLESTOWN, PA – November 1, 2010

Solardelphia, PA, NJ and DE's premier solar system designer and installer, has been recognized by the annual Philadelphia 100 Awards for its astounding 370% growth in 2010. In 2010, Solardelphia installed over 200kW in residential installations and completed 5 commercial solar installations, the largest of which is a 3.25MW of distributed generation PV. Solardelphia's 2010 residential installations alone are equivalent to reducing 190 tons of carbon dioxide emissions, removing 33 cars from the road or planting roughly 200 acres of trees.

Solardelphia's growth is a prime example of the job creation spurred by the expansion of the solar energy industry in the tri-state area. As a result of the PA Sunshine Program, the NJ Renewable Energy Incentive Program, Federal Tax Credits and sales of Solar Renewable Energy Credits, residential customers can see a payback period as short as 5-6 years, while commercial systems can pay for themselves in 3-4 years with annual ROIs as high as 15%. Solardelphia's success is credited to its knowledge of these programs to secure funding for its clients, as well as offering unique financing options through its longstanding partnership with SunPower Corporation.

"When I started Solardelphia in 2001, this was a niche market. I always imagined that the solar industry would evolve, prices would drop, states would step up and provide rebates and tax credits...but I had no idea it would be this dramatic and that Solardelphia would grow this quickly, it's very exciting." said Jude Webster, Founder and President of Solardelphia, "A very large segment of the population can now afford solar, which has always been my vision for the industry. Solardelphia's years of experience have paid off for us in expanding our operations in other states and developing utility-scale projects."

The majority of Solardelphia's 2010 projects were funded through PA and NJ rebate programs. NJ projects have showed a remarkable ROI due to lucrative SREC contracts and progressive solar policy in the Garden State. While PA currently lags behind neighboring states in pro-solar legislation, there was positive movement in the PA House and Senate this summer around a bill to increase the state's "Solar Share," which would increase PA utility's annual requirements to purchase SRECs. Solardelphia actively

participates in trade associations such as PASEIA, supporting efforts to raise PA's commitment to the deployment of solar.

Solardelphia's growth is also based upon the company's 9 years of experience in the solar industry and commitment to quality.
